Project summary

The objective of EGURALT is to apply and disseminate innovative solutions for the promotion of mid-rise timber construction in the SUDOE area, thus contributing to the global fight against climate change by promoting the use of natural materials from sustainable and renewable sources. Eight beneficiary entities from six regions of the SUDOE area are working in three fields: the promotion of mid-rise public timber buildings; the development of new technological timber products; and the transformation of the wood sector necessary for the paradigm shift in construction in the SUDOE area. The main contributions are: 1) the exchange of knowledge between technological poles, public authorities and industry through stakeholder tables, study visits...; 2) the application testing of new products and processes and dissemination with industry; and 3) the capitalization of knowledge through training courses for timber advisors in the construction industry. The EGURALT project is co-financed by FEDER funds within the framework of the Interreg SUDOE program. It has a FEDER budget of 1.011.562,20 € and is led by NASUVINSA (Navarra, Housing and Land), the public corporation of housing and urban development of the Government of Navarra (Spain).
